Their goal is to promote safety awareness in our community. Working together we can protect our investments being promoting community safety.

We have noticed several people driving at an excessive speed when travelling through the maintain streets in the community. The Guilford County Sheriff will be setting up Radar Trailer on the main streets to monitor traffic flow and aggressive driving patterns. Summer time bring out more walkers, joggers and children playing close to the streets. So please be mindful of people on the streets and please drive with cautious when travelling through the community. If they find it necessary, the next step is setting up speed traps in the community.

Recommendation:

Upgrade kit without the floating ball. Complete kits start at \$20. Flappers start at \$4. (At least change them)
