

**TRINITY LAKE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION
2017 SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

These rules and regulations are for the benefit and protection of all Trinity Lake, Homeowners Association members. These rules have been established to ensure the safety and sanitary operation of the pool facilities. Parents are requested to acquaint their children with these rules and caution them to observe them at all times.

1. **Homeowners Association dues must be current in order for the owner or tenant to use the pool and clubhouse facilities. There is no exception or waiver of this requirement.**
2. There is NO Lifeguard on Duty. The Association accepts no responsibility and all homeowners **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
3. Swimming Pool Hours: 8:00 A. M. to 8:00 P.M. during the pool season (Saturday May 27, 2017, to Labor Day – September 4, 2017). The pool hours are subject to change due to inclement weather conditions. These conditions include rain, thunder and lightening, and any conditions that places homeowners at risk.
4. **The Clubhouse Swimming Pool Facilities is Restricted to Trinity Lake Homeowners Association Members and Limited guest. Members Must Display a 2017 Pool Pass when entering the gate and upon request. A pool pass is not transferable and may not be given or used by anyone not in your immediate family/household.**
5. **Limited Guest will be allowed if accompanied by the homeowner/tenant. Guest entry into the pool is subject to occupancy at the time of visit. Homeowners have exclusive rights for use of the pool and limited guest is subject to limitations based on the homeowners use. Homeowner's private pool parties are strictly prohibited.**
6. **ALL PERSONS entering the Pool Facility name MUST appear on the SIGN IN LOG, including children and babies.** (Reason: Contact info may be required in the case of any health issues that may arise).
7. In consideration of the health of others, person having infectious diseases, inflame eyes, open sores, etc., are not permitted to use the pool.
8. All swimmers are required to shower **BEFORE** using the pool. There are no exceptions to this rule it is required at all pools operating in Guilford County.
9. Parents or other responsible guardians must accompany children under fourteen (14) years of age. If a child is not accompanied by an adult, they will not be allowed to swim. The adult must be present during the entire time the child is in the pool facility.
10. No pool equipment may be removed from pool area, if pool property is damaged, it will be charged to the responsible homeowner.
11. Glass bottles, containers, etc., in any form is strictly prohibited inside pool area. Place all trash and other refuse in proper receptacles. All personal items must be removed from the pool area upon departure.

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- 12. Running, pushing, wrestling and undue disturbance is prohibited in the pool or on the pool deck.**
- 13. Diving or jumping into the pool from the pool deck is not allowed.**
14. No animals or pets are allowed in the pool or on the pool deck.
15. All swimmers must wear proper attire. Blue jeans, T-shirts, cut-off, etc., do not constitute proper swimming attire and can cause expensive damage to the pool filtering equipment.
16. Infants wearing diapers **MUST WEAR RUBBER PANTS** over the diapers while in the pool. Do not use disposable diapers in pool as they disintegrate and clog the filtering system.
17. No one is allowed in the pool during an electrical storm. The pool may be closed at other times due to equipment breakdown, other operational defects, or contamination. A notification sign will be posted when possible.
18. One pool key is assigned to each household. If the key is lost, contact the management company for a replacement. The fee for a replacement is \$50.
19. Member shall hold neither the Association nor its agents responsible for any accident or injury arising out of the use of the pool.
20. Private pool parties are **Not Permitted**. The Association hosts one pool party every summer, which is the only authorized party.
- 21. Profanity, offensive or vulgar language is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.**
- 22. Violation of pool rules is subject to suspension or termination of pool privileges. Violations will be reported to the Board of Directors or the Management Company daily by the Pool Monitor.**
- 23. Three violations of the pool rules and regulations by member(s) of your household or guest will result in suspension of pool privileges. All rules and regulations will be strictly enforced so that all homeowners may have an enjoyable experience.**
- 24. Rental of the club house for personal functions Does Not give you or your guest exclusive rights to the pool. Limitations in Rule #5 will be strictly enforced.**
- 25. Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited inside the pool gate, deck, or pool area.**

These rules and regulations have been revised so that they are conducive to an enjoyable experience when families in this community use the pool. All residents are requested to lend their personal support in abiding by all the rules and regulations governing the pool and keeping the pool area clean.
